- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 11-09.1 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to enforcement of criminal violations by a home rule county; and to
- amend and reenact subsection 5 of section 11-09.1-05 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 4 relating to powers of a home rule county.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Subsection 5 of section 11-09.1-05 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
 - 5. Provide for the adoption, amendment, repeal, initiative, referral, enforcement, and civil and criminal penalties for violation of ordinances, resolutions, and regulations to carry out its governmental and proprietary powers and to provide for public health, safety, morals, and welfare. However, this subsection does not confer any authority to regulate any industry or activity which is regulated by state law or by rules adopted by a state agency.
 - **SECTION 2.** A new section to chapter 11-09.1 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:
- Enforcement of criminal penalties. A county that adopts a home rule charter and provides for the enforcement of criminal penalties in the charter may impose a penalty for a violation of an ordinance through a citation, a criminal complaint, or an information through the district court in the county where the offense occurred. The penalty for a violation of an
- 20 ordinance may be an infraction or a class B misdemeanor.
