1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact sections 26.1-21-01, 26.1-21-10, and 26.1-21-23 of the

2 North Dakota Century Code, relating to bonds of public employees and public officials.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 26.1-21-01 of the North Dakota Century Code is 5 amended and reenacted as follows:

6 **26.1-21-01. Definitions.** In this chapter, unless the context otherwise requires:

- "Blanket bond" means a bond that covers collectively all public employees and
 public officials without the necessity of scheduling names or positions as a part of
 the bond, and a bond whereby new public employees and new public officials
 entering employment or office during the period of the bond are automatically
 included without notice to the fund.
- 12 2. "Fund" means the state bonding fund.
- 3. "International peace garden" means an entity located upon the international
 boundary line between the United States of America and Canada used and
 maintained as a memorial to commemorate the long-existing relationship of peace
 and good will between the people and the governments of the United States of
 America and Canada and to further international peace among the nations of the
 world.
- Political subdivision" means all counties, townships, park districts, school districts,
 cities, and any other units of local government which are created either by statute
 or by the Constitution of North Dakota for local government or other public
 purposes.
- 23 5. "Public employee" means includes any person individual employed by the state or
 24 any of its political subdivisions, an officer or employee eligible under section

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1		57-15-56, an employee under section 61-16.1-05, and an officer or employee of an
2		international peace garden. "Public employee" does not include a person
3		employed by an occupational and professional board or commission under title 43
4		or by the state bar association, and any other employee or official required by
5		statute to provide a bond.
6	6.	"Public official" means includes any officer or deputy individual, either elected or

appointed, of the state or any of its political subdivisions who is required to be

- bonded by any law of this state, except for an officer of an occupational and
 professional board or commission under title 43 or of the state bar association.
- 10 7. "State" means state departments, agencies, industries, and institutions and an
 11 international peace garden.

SECTION 2. AMENDMENT. Section 26.1-21-10 of the North Dakota Century Code is
 amended and reenacted as follows:

14 26.1-21-10. Automatic insurance of state public employees and political 15 subdivisions public officials. The Each public employees employee and public officials of 16 the state and each political subdivision thereof, as the case may be, official must be insured in 17 the fund according to the provisions of this chapter upon application to the state bonding fund 18 and upon approval by the commissioner. Unless an application is denied within sixty days from 19 the date it is received by the state bonding fund, the application will be is deemed approved 20 and bond coverage in force. The provisions of this chapter and of any statute requiring a bond 21 constitute the bond of each and every public official for the purpose of any law of this state 22 requiring such bond and constitute the entire contract between the fund and the state or its 23 political subdivisions, respectively, as the obligee in any such bond. 24 SECTION 3. AMENDMENT. Section 26.1-21-23 of the North Dakota Century Code is 25 amended and reenacted as follows: 26 26.1-21-23. Public official may furnish private bond - Premiums payable from

public moneys only to fund. Any person individual elected or appointed to office, in lieu of
the bond provided for in this chapter, may furnish a bond issued by a duly authorized surety
company located within this state, but no officer or board of the state or of any political
subdivision may pay for any such a bond or bonds out of any public funds.
