

**Fifty-eighth Legislative Assembly of North Dakota
In Regular Session Commencing Tuesday, January 7, 2003**

HOUSE BILL NO. 1233
(Representatives Keiser, N. Johnson)
(Senators Klein, Mutch)

AN ACT to amend and reenact subsection 5 of section 26.1-17-33.1 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the powers of nonprofit mutual insurance companies; and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Subsection 5 of section 26.1-17-33.1 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

5. A nonprofit mutual insurance company may form a ~~stock~~ wholly owned company for the purpose of administering medicare claims and engaging in other business activities that do not accept insurance risk. A company established under this subsection may form a joint venture or subsidiary to conduct one or more of the functions the nonprofit mutual insurance company could conduct directly. An officer, a director, or a management employee of the nonprofit mutual insurance company may not directly or indirectly own an interest in a subsidiary.

SECTION 2. EMERGENCY. This Act is declared to be an emergency measure.
