- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 15.1-09 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to the payment of retention incentives by school boards.

## 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- SECTION 1. A new section to chapter 15.1-09 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:
  - School board authority Payment of retention incentives.
  - 1. The board of a school district may offer and, upon the signing of an employment contract by both parties, pay a retention incentive to an individual who:
    - a. Is licensed to teach by the education standards and practices board;
    - b. Is currently under contract with the district as a classroom teacher; and
  - c. Has a position defined as "difficult to fill" by the education standards and practices board.
- 13 2. The board may pay the retention incentive authorized by subsection 1 in:
  - a. One lump sum at the time the individual signs a contract of employment; or
  - b. Installments over a period of time not to exceed three years.
- 16 3. A retention incentive paid under this section:
- a. Is in addition to any amount payable under a negotiated teachers' contract;
- b. May not be included in the district's negotiated salary schedule; and
- c. May not be included as salary for continuing contract purposes.
