1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact two new subsections to section 43-52-03 of the North

2 Dakota Century Code, relating to exceptions to requirements for the practice of interpreting for

3 the deaf and hard of hearing.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

5 SECTION 1. Two new subsections to section 43-52-03 of the North Dakota Century
6 Code are created and enacted as follows:

- 7 An individual working in an elementary or secondary school who has successfully 8 completed a three-year educational interpreter certificate program of study or who 9 has passed the educational interpreter performance assessment at a level of 3.5 10 or higher. The individual may work in the school setting without national 11 certification until August 1, 2005, if the individual is being mentored by a trained 12 mentor who is either a certified interpreter or a deaf adult. To continue working in 13 the school setting after August 1, 2005, the individual must have obtained national 14 certification.
- An individual who has successfully completed an accredited interpreter training program from interpreting without certification for a period of up to two years from the date of completion of the program if, during that period, the individual is mentored by a trained mentor who is either a certified interpreter or a deaf adult.
