- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 39-04 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to collegiate number plates.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. A new section to chapter 39-04 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:

Collegiate number plates. Upon the request of a college or university in this state, the director, in cooperation with that college or university, shall design distinctive number plates displaying the colors and insignia of that college or university and bearing the letters signifying the college or university before the numbers on the plate. The director may not issue a collegiate number plate for a university or college unless at least the cost of the one-time fee for four hundred sets of plates is prepaid for that college or university. The director may issue the plates to the owner of a passenger motor vehicle or a truck the gross weight of which does not exceed ten thousand pounds [4535.92 kilograms]. The director may issue the collegiate number plates upon receiving, payment of a one-time fee of ten dollars, payment of all other fees required under this chapter for registration of a motor vehicle, and verification of payment of an annual surcharge of twenty dollars to be paid to the college or university corresponding to the number plate. The department shall collect the fees and surcharge, if paid to the director, under this section. The department shall pay the surcharge collected to the student academic scholarship fund or foundation of each institution for which a number plate was issued on a monthly basis.
