1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 12.1-33 of the North Dakota

2 Century Code, relating to the civil rights for misdemeanor domestic violence offenses; and to

3 provide for retroactive application.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

5 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 12.1-33 of the North Dakota Century Code is 6 created and enacted as follows:

Loss of civil rights for certain offenses. Except as provided in section 62.1-02-01,
upon conviction of a misdemeanor crime of domestic violence, the defendant loses all civil
rights, including the right to bear arms. Upon sentencing, the court shall restore those civil
rights to the defendant.

SECTION 2. RETROACTIVE APPLICATION. Upon a motion to a court by an individual convicted of a misdemeanor crime of domestic violence before the effective date of this Act, the court shall deem the individual to have the provisions of section 1 of this Act applied to that individual at the original time of conviction and sentencing and shall change the record to show the same.
