- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 20.1-03 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to deer license coupons; to amend and reenact subsections 3 and 4 of
- 3 section 20.1-03-12 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to big game hunting license
- 4 fees; to provide a penalty; and to provide an effective date.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Subsections 3 and 4 of section 20.1-03-12 of the North

  Dakota Century Code are amended and reenacted as follows:
  - For a resident big game hunting license, twenty twenty-five dollars, except the fee
    for a licensee under age sixteen is ten fifteen dollars, except as provided in a
    gubernatorial proclamation issued pursuant to section 20.1-08-04.1.
  - 4. For a nonresident big game hunting license, one hundred <u>fifty five sixty</u> dollars, and for a nonresident bow license, one hundred <u>fifty five sixty</u> dollars, and a nonrefundable five dollar application fee must accompany any lottery license fee under this subsection, except as provided in a gubernatorial proclamation issued pursuant to section 20.1-08-04.1.
- SECTION 2. A new section to chapter 20.1-03 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:
  - <u>Deer hunting license coupons Payments to landowner.</u> Each deer hunting license must have a coupon that may be detached from the license. The licenseholder may retain the coupon and submit it to the department under the provisions of this section or give it to the landowner on whose land the licenseholder takes or kills a deer. A licenseholder or a
- 22 landowner on whose land a deer is taken or killed who submits a coupon to the department by
- 23 February first following the close of deer hunting season is entitled to receive five dollars.

- 1 Coupons are not transferable and it is unlawful for an unauthorized person to attempt to or to
- 2 <u>collect any sum for a coupon to which that person is not entitled.</u>
- 3 **SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE.** This Act becomes effective on August 1, 2004.
