- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 15.1-31-02 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to grounds for the denial of open enrollment applications; and to declare an emergency.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 15.1-31-02 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 6 15.1-31-02. Open enrollment Grounds for denial Exception.
 - 1. Except as provided in section 15.1-31-04, the board of a student's school district of residence may deny an application under section 15.1-31-01 only if the application will result in a reduction of the number of students enrolled in the district by more than twenty percent of the average daily membership the previous school year.
- 11 However, if denying an
 - 2. Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection 1, the board of a school district may not deny an application for open enrollment if:
 - <u>Denying the</u> application would result in the enrollment of children from the same nuclear family in different school districts, the school board of the district of residence may not deny the application; or
 - <u>b.</u> The application for open enrollment is filed on behalf of a student whose
 district of residence took part in an election to approve a reorganization plan
 and if the reorganization plan was rejected under section 15.1-12-11.
- 20 **SECTION 2. EMERGENCY.** This Act is declared to be an emergency measure.
