1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact sections 37-15-07, 37-15-10.1, and 37-18.1-03 of the

2 North Dakota Century Code, relating to the administrator of the veterans' home and priorities

3 for admission to the veterans' home; and to declare an emergency.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

5 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 37-15-07 of the North Dakota Century Code is

6 amended and reenacted as follows:

37-15-07. Commandant Administrator of veterans' home - Appointment -

8 Qualifications - Term - Salary. The appointment, qualifications, term of office, and salary of

9 the commandant administrator of the veterans' home must be as prescribed in section

10 37-18.1-03.

SECTION 2. AMENDMENT. Section 37-15-10.1 of the North Dakota Century Code is
 amended and reenacted as follows:

37-15-10.1. Priorities for admission to veterans' home. If the veterans' home is full
and a waiting list for admission is necessary, further admission to the veterans' home must be

15 according to the following listing of priorities, so long as the individual meets the admission

- 16 requirements of sections 37-15-02 and 37-15-10:
- 17 1. Veterans with service connected disability.
- 18 2. American ex-prisoners of war.
- 19 3. Wartime veterans with nonservice-connected disability.
- 20 4. Wartime veterans.
- 21 5. Discharged North Dakota national guard members who became disabled in the
 22 line and discharge of duty.
- 23 6. Veterans with nonservice-connected disability.
- 24 7. Veterans.

3	An individu	al whose priority is higher than another individual's must be admitted before that	
4	other individ	dual priorities for admission to the facility appropriate to the different levels of care	
5	that are pro	vided by the veterans' home. The priorities for admission must be established by	
6	rule as provided under chapter 28-32.		
7	SEC	CTION 3. AMENDMENT. Section 37-18.1-03 of the North Dakota Century Code is	
8	amended a	nd reenacted as follows:	
9	37-1	18.1-03. Powers and duties of committee - Creation of subcommittees	
10	<u>subcommi</u>	ttee and governing board. The committee is responsible for organization, policy,	
11	and genera	I administration of all veterans' affairs in the state of North Dakota. It has the	
12	following powers and duties:		
13	1.	The chairman and secretary of the committee, acting jointly, shall appoint from the	
14		voting membership of the committee, two subcommittees: a subcommittee to be	
15		responsible for supervision and government of the veterans' home, and a	
16		subcommittee to be responsible for supervision and government of the department	
17		of veterans' affairs. Once appointed, a subcommittee member shall continue to	
18		serve as long as the member remains a voting member of the committee, unless	
19		removed from the subcommittee by the committee chairman and secretary, acting	
20		jointly. In no case may any one voting member serve on both subcommittees at	
21		the same time, and each nominating organization listed in section 37-18.1-01 must	
22		have at least one voting member nominated by it serving on each subcommittee.	
23		From the membership of each subcommittee, a chairman will be selected by	
24		majority vote to preside over it for the term of one year. No person may be	
25		permitted to serve as chairman of the committee and as chairman of a	
26		subcommittee simultaneously. A majority of the members of the subcommittee is	
27		required for a quorum, and a majority of the members present voting in favor	
28		thereof is required for any action a seven-member governing board for	
29		administration of the veterans' home, from within or outside the committee, subject	
30		to ratification of a majority vote of the committee, and shall establish term lengths	
31		for service on the governing board. The governing board has all ordinary powers	

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1	required of a governing board, including the power to establish qualifications for
2	and selection of an administrator and to establish an appropriate salary structure,
3	subject to limitations of legislative appropriation. The administrator serves at the
4	pleasure of the governing board.

5 2. The committee shall detail the specific powers and duties of each subcommittee 6 relating to supervision, government, and implementation of programs or services 7 provided by the veterans' home and the department of veterans' affairs The 8 chairman and secretary of the committee jointly shall appoint a subcommittee to be 9 responsible for supervision and government of the department of veterans' affairs. 10 Once appointed, a subcommittee member may continue to serve as long as the 11 member remains a voting member of the committee, unless removed from the 12 subcommittee by joint action of the committee chairman and secretary. A member 13 of the subcommittee may not serve on the governing board of the veterans' home. 14 Each nominating organization listed in section 37-18.1-01 must have at least one 15 voting member nominated by the organization serving on the subcommittee. The 16 subcommittee shall select by majority vote of the members a chairman to preside 17 for the term of one year.

18 3. The committee shall appoint the commandant of the veterans' home and the 19 commissioner of the department of veterans' affairs. Individuals appointed to 20 these positions The commissioner must be a bona fide residents resident of the 21 state, and must qualify as a veteran as defined in section 37-01-40. Their terms of 22 office are for two years, commencing on July 1, 1971, and on every second 23 anniversary thereof The commissioner serves at the pleasure of the committee. 24 The committee shall determine the salaries salary paid to the commandant of the 25 veterans' home and the commissioner of the department of veterans' affairs within 26 the limits of legislative appropriation. The commandant of the veterans' home and 27 the commissioner of veterans' affairs shall serve as the executive secretary for 28 their respective subcommittees the subcommittee. The commandant and the 29 commissioner have has no vote in the affairs of the subcommittees subcommittee. 30 4. The committee shall, under recommendation from each of its subcommittees the 31 board or the subcommittee, present any matters needing attention and action to

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1 the appropriate board, commission, agency, or department of the state, and the 2 North Dakota veterans' coordinating council. 3 The committee shall assure compliance with applicable federal and state laws in 5. 4 the administration of both the department of veterans' affairs and the North Dakota 5 veterans' home and shall exercise its responsibilities in all things necessary to 6 carry out the provisions of this chapter in regard to organization, policy, and 7 general administration of the agencies served and involved in the conduct of 8 veterans' affairs. The board governing the veterans' home and the subcommittee 9 governing the department of veterans' affairs shall conduct an annual performance 10 evaluation of the administrator and commissioner, respectively, with the evaluation 11 presented to the committee. The board and subcommittee shall create and implement a strategic plan for the veterans' home and the department of veterans' 12 affairs, respectively. The board and the committee annually shall report as to the 13 14 status of the respective strategic plan to the committee. After receiving a report, 15 the committee shall submit the report to the governor. 16 SECTION 4. EMERGENCY. This Act is declared to be an emergency measure.
