## Fifty-eighth Legislative Assembly of North Dakota In Regular Session Commencing Tuesday, January 7, 2003

HOUSE BILL NO. 1436 (Representative Pollert) (Senator Klein)

AN ACT to amend and reenact subsection 4 of section 43-17-18 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to licensure of physicians.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

**SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Subsection 4 of section 43-17-18 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

4. Special license. The board may grant a <u>temporary</u> special license to an applicant who is a graduate of <u>an international</u> <u>a</u> medical school <u>that is not located in the United States or Canada</u> if that applicant has met all requirements for licensure except those pertaining to postgraduate training <u>if the applicant</u>; has successfully completed <u>ene year two years</u> of approved postgraduate training in the United States or Canada; and is enrolled in a <u>residency an approved postgraduate training</u> program in this state. This special license is valid only <u>for the purpose of practicing medicine within the scope of the residency training program while the licensee continues to be enrolled in an approved postgraduate training program in this state.</u>
