4 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Subsection 2 of section 54-59-17 of the North Dakota 5 Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows: 6 2. The educational technology council consists of: 7 a. The chief information officer. 8 The superintendent of public instruction or the superintendent's designee. b. 9 The commissioner of higher education or the commissioner's designee. C. 10 d. A representative appointed by the state board for vocational and technical 11 education. 12 A representative appointed by the governor from a list of three nominees e. 13 submitted by the North Dakota association of technology leaders. 14 f. A representative appointed by the governor from a list of three nominees 15 submitted by the North Dakota council of educational leaders. 16 g. A representative appointed by the governor from a list of three nominees 17 submitted by the North Dakota school boards association. A representative appointed by the governor from a list of three nominees 18 h. 19 submitted by the North Dakota association of special education directors. 20 i. Two representatives of school districts, one of which A school district 21 representative who is appointed by the governor and who represents a school 22 district that has an enrollment in kindergarten through grade twelve of fewer 23 than four hundred, appointed by the governor.
