- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 15.1-27 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to a county equalization factor.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. A new section to chapter 15.1-27 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:

County equalization factor.

- 1. On or before October 15 of each year, each county auditor shall:
 - Determine the product of twenty mills times the equalized taxable valuation of property in each school district that has its administrative headquarters in the county; and
 - b. Certify the amount arrived at under this subsection to the superintendent of public instruction.
 - The superintendent of public instruction shall divide the amount certified under subsection 1 by the total number of students in average daily membership in all the school districts having their administrative headquarters in the county.
 - For each school district having its administrative headquarters in the county, the superintendent of public instruction shall multiply the per student amount arrived at under subsection 2 by the number of students in average daily membership in that school district.
- 4. The superintendent of public instruction shall subtract the product arrived at under subsection 3 from any amount to which the school district is otherwise entitled under section 15.1-27-05.
