- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact two new sections to chapter 4-38 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to organic food standards; to amend and reenact section 4-38-02 of the
- 3 North Dakota Century Code, relating to certifying agents; to repeal sections 4-38-01, 4-38-03,
- 4 4-38-04, 4-38-05, and 4-38-06 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to organic food
- 5 standards; and to provide a penalty.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 4-38-02 of the North Dakota Century Code is
 amended and reenacted as follows:
- 9 **4-38-02. Definitions.** As used in this chapter, unless the context otherwise requires:
 - "Certifying agent" means a person or persons registered with the North Dakota
 agriculture commissioner who have demonstrated to the North Dakota agriculture
 commissioner that they have the staff and expertise to carry out the requirements
 of certification as outlined in this chapter accredited by the United States
 department of agriculture as an organic certifying agent under 7 CFR part 205.
 - 2. "Organic food" means any food product, including meat, dairy, or a beverage, that is marketed or sold using the term or a derivative of the term organic food in the labeling or advertising of the product.
 - "Pesticides" means synthetic herbicides, insecticides, and fungicides, and all other toxic materials. The term does not include material from naturally derived substances.
- 4. "Synthetic fertilizer" means all nitrogen sources derived from ammonia;
 phosphorus derived from the acid treatment of rock phosphates; refined or highly
 soluble potassium salts, whether manufactured or mined; and all other chemically
 refined, synthesized, or acid treated material.

1 "Vendor" means any person who sells organic food to a consumer or another 2 vendor, or who processes, manufactures, or otherwise transforms an organic food 3 on behalf of a seller of organic food. 4 6. "Verification" means a system maintained by the vendor of organic foods that 5 demonstrates compliance to standards under which product identity may be traced 6 from farm to consumer, using a series of documents that record information about 7 the vendor's production and processing techniques, including records documenting 8 inspection visits by a certifying agent, records documenting inventory, and records 9 documenting adherence to standards. "Commissioner" means the agriculture 10 commissioner. 11 SECTION 2. A new section to chapter 4-38 of the North Dakota Century Code is 12 created and enacted as follows: 13 **Certifying agent - Registration.** Before a person may act as a certifying agent in this 14 state, the person must register with the commissioner on a form prescribed by the 15 commissioner. The form must include: 16 The name of the certifying agent: 1. 17 2. The name of all partners if the certifying agent is a partnership and all officers if the 18 certifying agent is a corporation; 19 3. A copy of the certifying agent's program requirements; 20 4. A copy of all documents relating to the certifying agent's certification process; 21 5. A copy of the certifying agent's letter of authorization or certificate of accreditation 22 issued by the national organic program; and 23 Any other information requested by the commissioner. 24 **SECTION 3.** A new section to chapter 4-38 of the North Dakota Century Code is 25 created and enacted as follows: 26 **Penalty.** A person that violates this chapter is guilty of a class B misdemeanor. 27 **SECTION 4. REPEAL.** Sections 4-38-01, 4-38-03, 4-38-04, 4-38-05, and 4-38-06 of 28 the North Dakota Century Code are repealed.
