1 A concurrent resolution for the amendment of section 4 of article XI of the Constitution of North 2 Dakota, relating to oaths of office of elected officials. 3 STATEMENT OF INTENT 4 This amendment provides that members of the executive branch are required to take the oath 5 prescribed by this section. 6 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE HOUSE OF 7 REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN: 8 That the following proposed amendment to section 4 of article XI of the Constitution of 9 North Dakota is agreed to and must be submitted to the qualified electors of North Dakota at 10 the general election to be held in 2004, in accordance with section 16 of article IV of the 11 Constitution of North Dakota. 12 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 4 of article XI of the Constitution of North Dakota is amended and reenacted as follows: 13 14 Section 4. Members of the legislative assembly and the executive and judicial 15 department branches, except such inferior officers as may be by law exempted shall, before 16 they the members enter on the duties of their respective offices, shall take and subscribe the 17 following oath or affirmation: "I do solemnly swear (or affirm as the case may be) that I will 18 support the Constitution of the United States and the Constitution of the State of North Dakota; and that I will faithfully discharge the duties of the office of \_\_\_\_\_ according to the best of 19

my ability, so help me God" (if an oath), (under pains and penalties of perjury) if an affirmation,

and no any other oath, declaration, or test shall may not be required as a qualification for any
