| 6 | BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE HOUSE OF |
| 7 | REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN: |
| 8 | That the following proposed amendment to section 4 of article XI of the Constitution of |
| 9 | North Dakota is agreed to and must be submitted to the qualified electors of North Dakota at |
| 10 | the general election to be held in 2004, in accordance with section 16 of article IV of the |
| 11 | Constitution of North Dakota. |
| 12 | SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 4 of article XI of the Constitution of North Dakota |
| 13 | is amended and reenacted as follows: |
| 14 | Section 4. Members of the legislative assembly and the executive and judicial |
| 15 | department branches, except such inferior officers as may be by law exempted shall, before |
| 16 | they the members enter on the duties of their respective offices, shall take and subscribe the |
| 17 | following oath or affirmation: "I do solemnly swear (or affirm as the case may be) that I will |
| 18 | support the Constitution of the United States and the Constitution of the State of North Dakota; |
| 19 | and that I will faithfully discharge the duties of the office of according to the best of |
| 20 | my ability, so help me God" (if an oath), (under pains and penalties of perjury) if an affirmation, |
| 21 | and no any other oath, declaration, or test shall may not be required as a qualification for any |
