3	WHEREAS, terrorism and pestilence pose serious threats to society that may require
4	extraordinary measures to protect the privacy, health, and safety of the citizens of this state;

6	WHEREAS, the federal government is evaluating and reorganizing federal agencies to
7	increase the national disaster readiness capability; and
8	WHEREAS, a review of disaster response readiness should be conducted on the state
9	level to determine the adequacy of current emergency powers of the executive branch of
10	government to ensure that this state is in a position to protect the health and welfare of its
11	citizens if an extraordinary event were to occur;
12	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES
13	OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:
14	That the Legislative Council study the emergency powers of the executive branch; and
15	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Legislative Council report its findings and
16	recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to
17	the Fifty-ninth Legislative Assembly.
