1 A concurrent resolution directing the Legislative Council to study the registration of landscape

2 architects and the landscape architecture laws of other states.

WHEREAS, the practice of landscape architecture is taught and recognized as a
professional service distinct from architecture; and

5 **WHEREAS**, a degree program is available and a degree can be obtained for landscape

6 architecture through a higher education program at North Dakota State University; and

7 WHEREAS, a majority of other states have recognized landscape architecture as a

8 licensed profession; and

9 **WHEREAS**, the laws in this state relating to the registration of architects, engineers,

10 and land surveyors do not recognize or regulate landscape architecture as a separate

11 profession; and

12 WHEREAS, any future practice of architecture, engineering, land surveying, and

13 landscape architecture will require careful consideration of overlapping practice and practice

14 distinct to each profession;

15 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES

16 OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

17 That the Legislative Council study the registration of landscape architects and the18 landscape architecture laws of other states; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Legislative Council report its findings and
 recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to
 the Fifty-ninth Legislative Assembly.
