## HOUSE BILL NO. 1145

- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact two new subsections to section 57-51-01 and a new
- 2 section to chapter 57-51 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to a temporary exemption
- 3 from the gross production tax for gas produced from shallow gas wells.

## 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. Two new subsections to section 57-51-01 of the North Dakota Century

Code are created and enacted as follows:

"Shallow gas" means gas produced from a gas well completed in or producing from

a shallow gas zone, as certified to the tax commissioner by the industrial commission.

"Shallow gas zone" means a strata or formation, including lignite or coal strata or seam, located above the depth of five thousand feet [1524 meters] below the surface, or located more than five thousand feet [1524 meters] below the surface but above the top of the Rierdon formation, from which gas is or may be produced.

**SECTION 2.** A new section to chapter 57-51 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:

**Shallow gas - Gross production tax exemption.** Shallow gas produced during the first twenty-four months of production from and after the date of first sales of gas from a well completed or recompleted in a shallow gas zone after the effective date of this Act is exempted from the gross production tax levied under section 57-51-02.2. Gas produced from such a well during testing prior to well completion or connection to a pipeline is also exempt from the gross production tax.
