- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact section 49-04-20 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to public utility fees; and to amend and reenact section 49-21-01.2 of the North Dakota
- 3 Century Code, relating to the exemption of rate and rate of return regulation for
- 4 telecommunications companies and telecommunications services.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- SECTION 1. Section 49-04-20 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:
- 8 **Public Utilities Fees.** Notwithstanding any other provision of this title, each public
- 9 <u>utility authorized to do business in North Dakota, including telecommunications companies,</u>
- 10 telecommunications cooperatives, electric utilities, gas utilities, electric cooperatives, and
- 11 pipeline utilities shall pay a one hundred dollar fee to the commission annually, on or before
- 12 July first. The commission shall deposit amounts received under this section in the general
- 13 fund.

- 14 **SECTION 2. AMENDMENT.** Section 49-21-01.2 of the North Dakota Century Code is
- 15 amended and reenacted as follows:
- 49-21-01.2. Exemption Rate regulation. Except as provided for in this chapter and
- 17 sections 49-02-01.1, 49-02-21, 49-02-22, and 49-04-02.1, <u>and 49-04-20</u>, telecommunications
- 18 companies and all telecommunications services are exempt from the provisions of chapters
- 19 49-02, 49-04, 49-05, and 49-06. Telecommunications companies and services are not subject
- 20 to rate or rate of return regulation. Any telecommunications company may elect not to be
- 21 subject to the provisions of this section and section 49-21-01.3, and to be subject to rate and
- 22 rate of return regulation, by filing an election with the commission in writing. For
- 23 telecommunications companies with over fifty thousand subscribers, the election not to be
- 24 exempt from rate and rate of return regulation is a one-time, irrevocable election.

- 1 Notwithstanding an election filed under this section, a telecommunications company is not
- 2 obligated to pay any fee for filing a price schedule or tariff.
