Page 2, replace lines 3 through 7 with:

"A coin-operated gaming device tax of twenty-five percent is imposed on the adjusted gross proceeds received from the conduct of coin-operated gaming devices. This tax is in place of any sales, use, excise, or gaming taxes provided for by law. The tax must be paid to the attorney general when tax returns are filed. One percent of the coin-operated gaming device tax, not to exceed five hundred thousand dollars per biennium, must be transferred to the state treasurer for deposit in the compulsive gambling prevention and treatment fund."
