- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 40-23-22.1 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to city flood control special assessments on privately owned structures, fixtures, and
- 3 improvements, used for private commercial purposes, which are located on state-owned land;
- 4 and to provide an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 40-23-22.1 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

40-23-22.1. City flood control special assessment exemption for state property <u>-</u> Limitations.

- 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, property of the state in a city subject to this section is exempt from special assessments levied for flood control purposes. Upon request by the governing body of the city, the exemption under this section may be completely or partially waived by majority vote of the budget section of the legislative council. A city is subject to the exemption under this section in recognition of state financial assistance for flood control provided to the city pursuant to section 61-02.1-01 or other appropriation or commitment of state funds.
- 2. The exemption under this section does not apply to any structure, fixture, or improvement located on state-owned land if the structure, fixture, or improvement is owned by a private entity and used by it for commercial purposes unless the net profit from the operation is dedicated to the state institution or agency that owns the land. An assessment allowed under this subsection must be based on the square footage or front footage of the land occupied by the structure, fixture, or
