- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 54-10-26 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to exempting draft audit reports prepared by the state auditor from open records
- 3 requirements.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 5 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 54-10-26 of the North Dakota Century Code is 6 amended and reenacted as follows:
- 7 54-10-26. State auditor's working papers and draft audit reports Confidential
- 8 Exemption from open records requirements Confidentiality. Working papers and draft
- 9 audit reports of the state auditor are not public records and are exempt from section 44-04-18.
- 10 Working papers include records kept by the auditor of the procedures applied, the tests
- 11 performed, the information obtained, and the pertinent conclusions reached in the engagement.
- 12 Working papers and draft audit reports may be, at the discretion of the state auditor and unless
- 13 otherwise prohibited by law, made available for inspection. A draft audit report released to the
- 14 governing body of the audited entity is confidential and exempt from section 44-04-18 until the
- 15 <u>final audit report is issued.</u> The issued audit report is public information. The working papers of
- 16 an issued audit report are public. At the discretion of the state auditor, all or a portion of the
- working papers of an issued audit report may be declared confidential. Such a The declaration
- 18 of confidentiality must state the reason for the confidentiality and the date, as can best be
- 19 reasonably determined at the time, when it the working papers will be made public.
