- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact sections 4-05.1-02, 4-05.1-04, 4-05.1-16, and
- 2 4-05.1-19 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the duties, responsibilities, and
- 3 membership of the state board of agricultural research and education.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

5 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 4-05.1-02 of the North Dakota Century Code is 6 amended and reenacted as follows:

4-05.1-02. Agricultural experiment station. The state board of agricultural research and education shall establish policies governing the direction and control of the North Dakota agricultural experiment station and the president of North Dakota state university shall control and administer the North Dakota agricultural experiment station, subject to the supervision of the state board of higher education. Funds appropriated to the agricultural experiment station

- may not be commingled with funds appropriated to North Dakota state university.
- 13 Appropriation requests to defray expenses of the agricultural experiment station must be
- 14 separate from appropriation requests to defray expenses of North Dakota state university.
 - **SECTION 2. AMENDMENT.** Section 4-05.1-04 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 17 **4-05.1-04. Reports.** Each center director shall submit an annual report to the station
- 18 director as directed by the state board of agricultural research and education president of North
- 19 <u>Dakota state university</u>. Each report must set forth in detail the investigations and experiments
- 20 made during the preceding year, recommendations for the welfare of the center, the financial
- 21 condition of the center, how all moneys have been expended, and the results of experiments.
- 22 The station director shall submit these reports, with a report of the North Dakota state university
- 23 main research center, to the state board of agricultural research and education and the state
- 24 board of higher education on or before the first day of September of each year. If the state

2	accordance with section 54-06-04, the report must include a composite of the reports from the

8	1.	The	state board of agricultural research and education consists of:		
9		a.	The president of North Dakota state university or the president's designee;		
10		b.	The vice president of agricultural affairs at North Dakota state university, who		
11			serves in an ex officio nonvoting capacity;		
12		c.	The administrator of the agricultural experiment station, who serves in an		
13			ex officio nonvoting capacity;		
14		d.	The five persons Five individuals appointed to the agricultural consultation		
15			board by the ag coalition and serving in that capacity on July 1, 1997;		
16	e.	<u>b.</u>	The five persons Five individuals appointed to the agricultural consultation		
17			board by the extension service's multicounty program units and serving in that		
18			capacity on July 1, 1997;		
19		f .	The two persons appointed to the agricultural consultation board by the		
20			president of North Dakota state university as representatives of the state's		
21			research extension centers and serving in that capacity on July 1, 1997;		
22		g.	The agriculture commissioner, who serves in an ex officio nonvoting capacity;		
23		h.	The director of the North Dakota state university extension service, who		
24			serves in an ex officio nonvoting capacity; and		
25	i.	<u>c.</u>	Two members of the legislative assembly appointed by the chairman of the		
26			legislative council. The chairman shall appoint one member from each		
27			political faction. The terms of members are for two years, and members may		
28			be reappointed. The legislative council shall pay the compensation and		
29			expense reimbursement for the legislative members.		
30	2.	As t	he terms of office held on the effective date of this Act by individuals listed in		
31		subo	divisions a and b of subsection 1 expire, the ag coalition shall provide to the		

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1 governor a list of two names for each position and the governor shall appoint an 2 individual to each position from that list. 3 3. The initial five members appointed by the ag coalition shall select their terms 4 by lot so that one member serves for one year, one member serves for two 5 years, one member serves for three years, one member serves for four years, 6 and one member serves for five years. 7 The initial five members appointed by the extension service's multicounty b. 8 program units shall select their terms by lot so that one member serves for 9 one year, one member serves for two years, one member serves for three 10 years, one member serves for four years, and one member serves for five 11 years. 12 C. The two persons appointed as representatives of the state's research 13 extension centers shall serve only through June 30, 1998. 14 3. 4. At the completion of each initial term, the term of office for each member is five 15 years, beginning on July first. No person may be appointed to a second five-year 16 term. 17 At least ninety days before the conclusion of the initial term of each member -а. 18 appointed by the ag coalition, the ag coalition shall provide to the state board 19 of higher education a list of one or more names from which the state board of 20 higher education shall appoint a successor. Future appointments to these 21 five positions must be made in the same manner. The state board of higher 22 education shall ensure that four out of the five seats are held by agricultural 23 producers. 24 At least ninety days before the conclusion of the initial term of each member 25 appointed by the extension service's multicounty program units, the units 26 through their advisory groups shall provide to the state board of higher 27 education a list of one or more names from which the state board of higher 28 education shall appoint a successor. Future appointments to these five 29 positions must be made in the same manner. The state board of higher 30 education shall ensure that four out of the five seats are held by agricultural

producers.

1	SEC	CTION 4. AMENDMENT. Section 4-05.1-19 of the North Dakota Century Code is
2	amended a	nd reenacted as follows:
3	4-0	5.1-19. State board of agricultural research and education - Duties. Within the
4	policies of t	he state board of higher education, the state board of agricultural research and
5	education is	s responsible for budgeting and policymaking establishing and directing policies
6	associated	with the agricultural experiment station and the North Dakota state university
7	extension s	ervice. The board of agricultural research and education shall:
8	1.	Determine the causes of any adverse economic impacts on crops and livestock
9		produced in this state;
10	2.	Develop ongoing strategies for the provision of research solutions and resources
11		to negate adverse economic impacts on crops and livestock produced in this state;
12	3.	Develop ongoing strategies for the dissemination of research information through
13		the extension service;
14	4.	Implement Collaborate with the president of North Dakota state university to
15		implement the strategies developed under subsections subsection 2 and 3, subject
16		to approval by the state board of higher education;
17	5.	Develop, with the agricultural experiment station and the North Dakota state
18		university extension service, an annual
19	<u>4.</u>	Receive budget development updates from the president of North Dakota state
20		university and upon completion review and approve the biennial budget for the
21		operations of these entities;
22	6.	Develop a biennial budget request and submit that request to the president of
23		North Dakota state university and the state board of higher education;
24	7.	Maximize the use of existing financial resources, equipment, and facilities to
25		generate the greatest economic benefit from research and extension efforts and to
26		promote efficiency the agricultural experiment station and the North Dakota state
27		university extension service;
28	8. <u>5.</u>	Annually evaluate the results of research and extension activities and expenditures
29		and report provide the findings to the budget section of the legislative council and
30		the state board of higher education;

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1	9.	Advise the president of North Dakota state university regarding the recruitment,
2		selection, and performance of the vice president of agricultural affairs, the
3		extension service director, and the station director; and
4	10. <u>6.</u>	Present a status report Annually provide to the budget section of the legislative
5		council a five-year plan that addresses the future of agriculture in this state and the
6		role of the agricultural experiment station in that vision.
