- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact sections 25-03.2-03.1 and 50-11-02.3 of the North
- 2 Dakota Century Code, relating to continuing a moratorium on the expansion of residential
- 3 treatment center for children and residential child care facility or group home bed capacity; to
- 4 provide an expiration date; and to declare an emergency.

## 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 6 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 25-03.2-03.1 of the North Dakota Century Code 7 is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 8 25-03.2-03.1. (Effective through June 30, 2003) Moratorium on expansion of
- 10 and 25-03.2-08, unless a needs assessment conducted by the department indicates a need for

residential treatment center for children bed capacity. Notwithstanding sections 25-03.2-03

- 11 the licensing of additional bed capacity, the department may not issue a license under this
- 12 chapter for any additional bed capacity for a residential treatment center for children above the
- 13 state's gross number of beds licensed as of June 30, <del>1999</del> 2003.
- SECTION 2. AMENDMENT. Section 50-11-02.3 of the North Dakota Century Code is
- 15 amended and reenacted as follows:
- 50-11-02.3. (Effective through June 30, 2003) Moratorium on expansion of
- 17 residential child care facility or group home bed capacity. Notwithstanding sections
- 18 50-11-02 and 50-11-09, unless a needs assessment conducted by the department indicates a
- 19 need for the licensing of additional bed capacity, the department may not issue a license under
- 20 this chapter for any additional bed capacity for a residential child care facility or a group home
- 21 above the state's gross number of beds licensed as of June 30, <del>1999</del> 2003.
- 22 **SECTION 3. EXPIRATION DATE.** This Act is effective through June 30, 2005, and
- 23 after that date is ineffective.
- 24 **SECTION 4. EMERGENCY.** This Act is declared to be an emergency measure.
