- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact subdivision j of subsection 2 of section 39-04-18 of the
- 2 North Dakota Century Code, relating to disabled American veterans' number plates.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Subdivision j of subsection 2 of section 39-04-18 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
 - j. Passenger motor vehicles, house cars, or pickup trucks not exceeding ten thousand pounds [4535.92 kilograms] gross weight owned and operated by a disabled veteran under the provisions of Public Law 79-663 [38 U.S.C. 3901] or who has a one hundred percent service-connected disability as determined by the department of veterans' affairs who is entitled to display a distinctive license number plate issued by the department upon the payment of a fee of five dollars. This exemption applies to no more than two such motor vehicles owned by a disabled veteran at any one time. The plate must be marked with the internationally accepted symbol of access for the mobility impaired.
