1	A concurrent resolution urging Governor John Hoeven to continue his efforts to provide for the
2	needs of the state's most vulnerable citizens by using Bank of North Dakota and State Mill and
3	Elevator profits and moneys in trust funds for general fund purposes without requiring any
4	general tax increase in the budget submitted to the Fifty-eighth Legislative Assembly.
5	WHEREAS, Bank of North Dakota and State Mill and Elevator profits have been used
6	frequently to supplement the state general fund; and
7	WHEREAS, the Governor's proposed budget includes spending of \$60 million from the
8	profits of the Bank of North Dakota, \$5 million from the profits of the State Mill and Elevator,

WHEREAS, the use of Bank of North Dakota and State Mill and Elevator profits and trust funds for general fund purposes has made it possible for a balanced budget without the need for any general tax increases while continuing to provide for the needs of our most vulnerable citizens;

\$26 million from the student loan trust fund, \$14.3 million from the Permanent Oil Trust Fund,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN:

That the Fifty-eighth Legislative Assembly urges Governor John Hoeven to continue his efforts to provide for the needs of the state's most vulnerable citizens by using Bank of North Dakota and State Mill and Elevator profits and moneys in trust funds for general fund purposes without requiring any general tax increase in the budget submitted to the Fifty-eighth Legislative Assembly; and
