- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 26.1-02-27 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to disclosing nonpublic personal information.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 26.1-02-27 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 6 **26.1-02-27. Disclosing nonpublic personal information.** An insurance company,
- 7 nonprofit health service corporation, or health maintenance organization may not disclose
- 8 nonpublic personal information contrary to the provisions of title V of the Gramm-Leach-Bliley
- 9 Act [Pub. L. 106-102; 113 Stat. 1436]. The commissioner may adopt rules as may be
- 10 necessary to carry out this section. The rules must be consistent with and not more restrictive
- 11 than the model regulation adopted by the national association of insurance commissioners
- 12 entitled "Privacy of Consumer Financial and Health Information Regulation". Notwithstanding
- 13 the provisions of the previous sentence, the rules must, subject to the exceptions including the
- 14 affiliate sharing exception provided for in the national association of insurance commissioner's
- model regulation, prohibit the disclosure of nonpublic personal health and financial information
- 16 concerning an individual unless an authorization is obtained from the individual whose
- 17 nonpublic personal health and financial information is sought to be disclosed. This section does
- 18 not create a private right of action.
