SB 2229: A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact subdivision d of subsection 1 of section 51-05.1-03 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to grounds for refusal, suspension, or revocation of an auctioneer's or auction clerk's license.

Was read the first time and referred to the **Political Subdivisions Committee**.

FIRST READING OF SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTIONS

SCR 4006: A concurrent resolution commending the volunteers and staff of the Dollars for Scholars program for being selected to establish a state office and commending the 7,500 young North Dakota scholarship recipients for their hard work and dedication to the pursuit of education.

Sens. Krauter, Nichols, Urlacher and Reps. Kerzman, Mueller, Nelson introduced:

SCR 4007: A concurrent resolution urging the President and Congress to end the embargo on United States agricultural and manufactured products and expand trade with the Republic of Cuba.
