- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 26.1-36 and a new section to
- 2 chapter 54-52.1 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to health insurance coverage and
- 3 public employee health insurance coverage for certain outpatient prescription drugs and
- 4 devices.

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BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. A new section to chapter 26.1-36 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:

Health insurance policy and health insurance contract - Coverage for certain outpatient prescription drugs and devices. An insurance company, a nonprofit health service corporation, or a health maintenance organization may not deliver, issue, execute, or renew any health insurance policy, health service contract, or evidence of coverage that provides benefits for outpatient prescription drugs or devices on an individual, group, blanket, franchise, or association basis unless the policy, contract, or evidence of coverage provides benefits for outpatient prescription drugs or devices of the same type offered under the policy or contract for other outpatient prescription drugs or devices for health services to any person covered under the policy or contract for outpatient hormone replacement therapy, regardless of whether a woman is perimenopausal or postmenopausal; contraceptives, including emergency contraceptives; infertility therapy; and osteoporosis treatment and management.

SECTION 2. A new section to chapter 54-52.1 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:

Insurance to cover certain outpatient prescription drugs and devices. The board shall provide medical benefits coverage under a contract for insurance pursuant to section 54-52.1-04 or under a self-insurance plan pursuant to section 54-52.1-04.2 for outpatient prescription drugs and devices in the same manner as provided under section 1 of this Act.
