1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 39-03-13 of the North Dakota Century Code,

2 relating to discipline of members of the highway patrol.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 39-03-13 of the North Dakota Century Code is
amended and reenacted as follows:

39-03-13. Additional powers of superintendent. In addition to the superintendent's
powers as a member of the highway patrol, the superintendent of the patrol has the following
powers as administrative head of the patrol:

- The superintendent may organize the patrol into divisions, bureaus, and districts as
 the superintendent deems necessary.
- The superintendent may designate ranks, fix salaries with appropriate allowances
 for those ranks, and establish promotional procedures.
- The superintendent may take reasonable disciplinary action against members of
 the patrol for inefficiency, misconduct, insubordination, or violation of an
- 15 established rule, whenever the superintendent deems the actions necessary,

16 provided that:

- a. Where <u>If</u> demotion in rank is summarily ordered against a member of the
 patrol as a disciplinary measure, to be <u>the demotion is</u> limited to a one-grade
 reduction in rank, the order is appealable under chapter 54-44.3.
- b. Where <u>If</u> a reduction in pay of a member of the patrol is summarily ordered as
 a disciplinary measure, it must be <u>the reduction in pay is</u> limited to one year's
 duration and the order is appealable under chapter 54-44.3.
- c. Suspension of pay for a member of the patrol for a period not exceeding
 seven days may be summarily ordered as a Every disciplinary measure, but

1	an order for suspension of pay for a longer period action is appealable in the
2	same manner as under chapter 54-44.3.

- 4. A suspension of pay for a member of the patrol may be summarily ordered not
 more than twice in one year as separate disciplinary measures, except that further
