1 A BILL for an Act to limit the disclosure of information by consumer reporting agencies.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

## 3 SECTION 1. Limitation on information disclosed by consumer reporting 4 agencies. A consumer reporting agency may not disclose a person's nonpublic personal 5 information to a third party, regardless of whether that third party is affiliated with the consumer 6 reporting agency, unless the consumer reporting agency has first received the consent of the 7 person to which the information pertains. A valid consent under this section must meet the 8 requirements of section 6-08.1-04. A consumer reporting agency is exempt from the 9 authorization requirements of this section if the disclosure is required to be permitted under the 10 federal Fair Credit Reporting Act [Pub. L. 90-321; 15 U.S.C. 1681 et seq.]. The provisions of 11 the federal Financial Services Modernization Act of 1999 [Pub. L. 106-102; 113 Stat. 1437; 12 15 U.S.C. 6801 et seq.] do not exempt a consumer reporting agency from the authorization 13 requirements of this section. This section does not restrict the disclosure of information for the 14 purpose of law enforcement.
