- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 26.1-21-09.1 of the North Dakota Century
- 2 Code, relating to bonds of agents appointed to distribute hunting and fishing licenses or stamps.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 26.1-21-09.1 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 6 26.1-21-09.1. Bonds of agents appointed to distribute hunting and fishing 7 licenses or stamps - Premiums - Determination of eligibility. The annual premium for a 8 bond of an agent appointed by a county auditor to distribute hunting and fishing licenses or 9 stamps pursuant to section 20.1-03-17 is ten dollars. The premium must be paid to the fund 10 pursuant to rules adopted by the commissioner. The commissioner shall deposit the premiums 11 with the state treasurer to the credit of the fund. The commissioner may reduce or waive the 12 premium if it is determined that funds received pursuant to this section are sufficient to cover 13 potential claims on the bonds of agents appointed to distribute hunting and fishing licenses or 14 stamps. The commissioner shall determine the conditions and qualifications of agents bonded 15 under this section. The amount of coverage afforded under this section is limited to five fifteen
