HOUSE BILL NO. 1277 (Representatives Koppelman, Boehning, DeKrey, Kingsbury, Wieland) (Senator J. Lee)

AN ACT to amend and reenact section 39-06-16 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the display of a motor vehicle operator's license.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 39-06-16 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

39-06-16. License to be carried and exhibited on demand. Every <u>A</u> licensee shall have the licensee's operator's license or permit in the licensee's immediate possession at all times when operating a motor vehicle and shall display physically surrender the same license or permit, upon demand of any district court, municipal court, a patrolman, peace officer, or a field deputy or inspector of the department. However, no <u>a</u> person charged with violating this section may <u>not</u> be convicted or assessed any court costs if the person produces in court, to the chief of police, or in the office of the arresting officer an operator's license or permit theretofore issued to that person and valid and not under suspension, revocation, or cancellation at the time of the person's arrest.
