- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 39-13 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to a logo sign program.

## 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 39-13 of the North Dakota Century Code is 5 created and enacted as follows:

- 6 Logo sign program.
- Notwithstanding section 24-01-12, the director shall establish a logo sign program
   for the purpose of providing on the right of way of the state highway system
   specific information on gas, food, camping, and lodging for the benefit of the
   motoring public.
- 11 2. By public negotiation or bid, the director shall contract with a qualified business to 12 erect and maintain, on the right of way of the state highway system, signs 13 informing the motoring public of gas, food, lodging, and camping facilities. The 14 director shall give preference to a business that has a place of business and 15 employees in this state so as to be capable of installing, maintaining, and replacing 16 signs. The business shall furnish, install, maintain, and replace signs for the 17 benefit of advertisers who provide gas, food, lodging, and camping facilities for the 18 general public, and lease advertising space on the signs to operators of these 19 facilities.
- All costs incurred under the program established by this section must be paid
   under an agreement negotiated between the business and an advertiser or
   advertisers unless otherwise provided in the contract between the director and the
   business.

- An agreement between the director and the business must conform with federal
   standards adopted under 23 U.S.C. 131(f) and with the manual of uniform
   traffic-control devices adopted under section 39-13-06. The director may require
   additional terms and conditions. All contracts made by the director with a business
   must provide that the business obtain liability insurance in an amount the director
   determines, jointly insuring the state and the business against all liability for claims
   for damages occurring wholly or in part because of the business.
- 5. The director may not take any action under this section which will result in the loss
  to the state of any federal highway construction funds.
