1 A BILL for an Act to provide the burden of proof in actions for certain credit card charges.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. Unsolicited credit cards - Debt - Burden of proof. In an action in which a credit card company seeks payment from an individual for charges made to a credit card, if the individual claims that the individual did not solicit the credit card, that the individual did not enter into a contractual relationship with the credit card company for purposes of opening a credit card account, and that charges made to the credit card were not made by the individual, the credit card company bears the burden of proving by clear and convincing evidence that one or more of the individual's claims is untrue before the action may proceed.
