- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 20.1-02 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, related to elk management.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- SECTION 1. A new section to chapter 20.1-02 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:
- 6 **Wild elk management Survey and responsibilities.** The department shall
- 7 periodically conduct a random survey of all resident big game hunters and private landowners.
- 8 The department shall design the survey to determine the best options for relocating wild elk
- 9 from Theodore Roosevelt national park to other suitable areas within the state. The department
- 10 shall use survey results in collaboration with other state and federal agencies and conservation
- 11 organizations to create and implement a program to accept and relocate wild elk whenever
- 12 deemed necessary by the national park service. The department shall create, implement, and
- 13 administer the wild elk relocation program. The department shall complete the first survey to
- 14 begin this process by December 31, 2003, and shall pay for the survey by utilizing necessary
- 15 funds held in reserve by the department.
