1 A BILL for an Act to provide for a state capitol entrance competition.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. State capitol entrance design competition. Notwithstanding any other law, the capitol grounds planning commission may administer a competition for the redesign of the south entrance to the state capitol. The competition is open to architects registered in this state, and the purpose is to select a new design that meets security needs and is esthetically pleasing. The commission shall give residents of this state the opportunity to comment on the three best submittals that meet the commission's minimum design and construction criteria. The commission shall award the runnerup ten thousand dollars and the third-place winner five 10 thousand dollars. The commission shall award the contract for the design of the project to the 11 first-place winner. The capitol grounds planning commission shall fund the competition and the 12 project from funds available to the commission.
