1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 12.1-17 of the North Dakota

2 Century Code, relating to mandated treatment for domestic violence offenders; and to amend

3 and reenact sections 12.1-17-01 and 14-07.1-06 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to

4 mandated treatment of domestic violence offenders and to the violation of a protection order.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

6 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 12.1-17-01 of the North Dakota Century Code is 7 amended and reenacted as follows:

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12.1-17-01. Simple assault.

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9	1	A pe	erson is guilty of an offense if that person:
10		a.	Willfully causes bodily injury to another human being; or
11		b.	Negligently causes bodily injury to another human being by means of a
12			firearm, destructive device, or other weapon, the use of which against a
13			human being is likely to cause death or serious bodily injury.
14	2	 The	offense is:
15		a.	A class C felony when the victim is a peace officer or correctional institution
16			employee acting in an official capacity, which the actor knows to be a fact, a
17			person engaged in a judicial proceeding, or a member of a municipal or
18			volunteer fire department or emergency medical services personnel unit or
19			emergency department worker in the performance of the member's duties.
20		b.	A class B misdemeanor for the first offense when the victim is an actor's
21			family or household member as defined in subsection 4 of section 14-07.1-01
22			and a class A misdemeanor for a second or subsequent offense when the
23			victim is an actor's family or household member as defined in subsection 4 of
24			section 14-07.1-01 and the actor has a prior conviction for simple assault

1	involving the commission of domestic violence as defined in subsection 2 of			
2	section 14-07.1-01. For purposes of this subdivision, a prior conviction			
3	includes a conviction of simple assault in which a finding of domestic violence			
4	was made under a law or ordinance of another state which is equivalent to			
5	this subdivision.			
6	c. A class B misdemeanor except as provided in subdivision a or b.			
7	3. The sentence for an offense against an actor's family or household member as			
8	defined in subsection 4 of section 14-07.1-01 must include an order to complete a			
9	domestic violence offender treatment program, unless the court makes written			
10	findings for the record explaining why such a sentence would be inappropriate.			
11	SECTION 2. A new section to chapter 12.1-17 of the North Dakota Century Code is			
12	created and enacted as follows:			
13	Mandated treatment of domestic violence offenders. The sentence for an offense			
14	under section 12.1-17-01, 12.1-17-01.1, 12.1-17-02, 12.1-17-03, 12.1-17-04, or 12.1-17-05			
15	against an actor's family or household member, as defined in subsection 4 of section			
16	14-07.1-01, must include an order to complete a domestic violence offender treatment program			
17	unless the court makes written findings for the record explaining why such an order would be			
18	inappropriate.			
19	SECTION 3. AMENDMENT. Section 14-07.1-06 of the North Dakota Century Code is			
20	amended and reenacted as follows:			
21	14-07.1-06. Penalty for violation of a protection order. Whenever a protection order			
22	is granted under section 14-07.1-02 or 14-07.1-03 and the respondent or person individual to			
23	be restrained has been served a copy of the order, a the first violation of the any order is a			
24	class A misdemeanor and also constitutes contempt of court. A second or subsequent violation			
25	of a any protection order is a class C felony. Violation of a foreign protection order entitled to			
26	full faith and credit recognition under section 14-07.1-02.2 is a class A misdemeanor. A second			
27	or subsequent violation of such an order is a class C felony. For purposes of this section, "first			
28	violation" means the first time any order is violated and a second or subsequent violation of any			
29	protection order includes two or more violations of protection orders.
