

HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 3008

Introduced by

1 A concurrent resolution directing the Legislative Council to study the use of electronic home
2 detention for nonviolent offenders.

3 **WHEREAS**, house arrest is included as a sentencing alternative for courts to impose as
4 a condition of probation; and

5 **WHEREAS**, electronic home detention can be used as a form of house arrest, instead
6 of imprisonment, for certain persons convicted of nonviolent offenses, such as driving while
7 under the influence; and

8 **WHEREAS**, more extensive use of electronic home detention could lower workloads of
9 department of corrections and rehabilitation personnel and save the state money while
10 providing adequate security and meaningful punishment;

11 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES**
12 **OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:**

13 That the Legislative Council study the use of electronic home detention for nonviolent
14 offenders; and

15 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Legislative Council report its findings and
16 recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to
17 the Fifty-ninth Legislative Assembly.
