- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 43-45-07.1 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to the licensure of addiction counselors.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 4 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 43-45-07.1 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 6 **43-45-07.1. Grounds for disciplinary proceedings.** The board may deny an
- 7 application, refuse to renew, suspend, revoke, or place on probationary status any license
- 8 issued under this chapter on proof at a hearing that the applicant or holder of the license has
- 9 engaged in unprofessional conduct. Unprofessional conduct includes:
- 1. Obtaining an initial license or renewal by means of fraud, misrepresentation, or concealment of material facts.
- 12 2. Violating rules set by the board.
- 13 3. Violating a provision of this chapter.
- 4. Violating the professional code of conduct as adopted by the board.
- Being adjudged guilty of an offense determined by the board to have a direct
 bearing on an applicant's or holder of the license's ability to serve the public as an
- 17 addiction counselor or being adjudged guilty of any offense and being insufficiently
- rehabilitated as determined by the board under section 12.1-33-02.1.
- 19 One year from the date of the revocation, the license holder may make application for initial
- 20 licensure.
