1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact chapter 50-32 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating

2 to licensing of assisted living facilities; to amend and reenact subsection 8 of section 23-09-01

3 and sections 50-24.5-01 and 50-24.5-02 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to assisted

4 living facilities; to repeal section 50-24.5-02.1 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to

5 registration of assisted living facilities; and to provide a penalty.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

7	SEC	CTION 1. AMENDMENT. Subsection 8 of section 23-09-01 of the North Dakota
8	Century Co	de is amended and reenacted as follows:
9	8.	"Lodging establishment" includes every building or structure, or any part thereof,
10		which is kept, used, maintained, or held out to the public as a place where sleeping
11		accommodations are furnished for pay to four or more transient guests. The term
12		does not include a facility providing personal care services directly or through
13		contract services as defined in section 23-09.3-01 or 50-24.5-01 50-32-01.
14	SEC	CTION 2. AMENDMENT. Section 50-24.5-01 of the North Dakota Century Code is
15	amended a	nd reenacted as follows:

6		services beyond food or shelter to five or more individuals who are not related to
7		the proprietor.
8	12.	"Instrumental activities of daily living" means activities to support independent
9		living including housekeeping, shopping, laundry, transportation, and meal
10		preparation.
11	13. <u>9.</u>	"Living independently" includes living in congregate housing. The term does not
12		include living in an institution.
13	14.	"Living unit" means a portion of an assisted living facility occupied as the living
14		quarters of an individual who has entered into a lease agreement with the assisted
15		living facility.
16	15. <u>10.</u>	"Proprietor" means an individual responsible for day-to-day administration and
17		management of a facility.
18	16. <u>11.</u>	"Qualified service provider" means a county agency or independent contractor who
19		agrees to meet standards for services and operations established by the
20		department.
21	17.	"Related by blood or marriage to the owner or manager" means an individual who
22		is a spouse or former spouse of the owner or manager or is a parent, stepparent,
23		grandparent, stepgrandparent, child, stepchild, grandchild, stepgrandchild, brother,

25		or the owner or manager's spouse or former spouse.

2			eligible beneficiary's physical or mental disability and the restoration of an eligible
3			beneficiary to the beneficiary's best possible functional level.
4		20.	"Tenant" means an adult individual who has entered into a lease agreement with
5			an assisted living facility.
6	21.	<u>14.</u>	"Would be eligible to receive the cash benefits except for income" refers to an
7			individual whose countable income, less the cost of necessary remedial care that
8			may be provided under this chapter, does not exceed an amount equal to the cash
9			benefit under title XVI of the Social Security Act [42 U.S.C. 1381 et seq.] which the
10			individual would receive if the individual had no income, plus sixty dollars.
11		SEC	CTION 3. AMENDMENT. Section 50-24.5-02 of the North Dakota Century Code is
12	amen	ded a	nd reenacted as follows:
13		50-2	24.5-02. Powers and duties of the department. The department shall:
14		1.	Administer aid to vulnerable aged, blind, and disabled persons and supervise and
15			direct county agencies in the administration of aid to vulnerable aged, blind, and
16			disabled persons.
17		2.	Supplement, within the limits of legislative appropriation, the income of an eligible
18			beneficiary receiving necessary adult family foster care services to the extent that
19			the eligible beneficiary lacks income sufficient to meet the cost of that care
20			provided at rates determined by the department.
21		3.	Supplement, within the limits of legislative appropriation, the income of an eligible
22			beneficiary receiving necessary basic care services to the extent that the eligible
23			beneficiary lacks income sufficient to meet the cost of that care, provided at rates
24			determined by the department.
25		4.	Pay qualified service providers at rates determined by the department, within the
26			limits of legislative appropriation, for the provision of the following services
27			provided to an eligible beneficiary to the extent that the eligible beneficiary lacks
28			income sufficient to meet the cost of these services:
29			a. Homemaker services;
30			b. Chore services;
31			c. Respite care;

	d. Home health aide services;
	f. Family home care;
	g. Personal attendant care;
	h. Adult family foster care;
	i. Adaptive assessment; and
	j. Other services the department determines to be essential and appropriate to
	sustain an individual in the individual's home and community and to delay or
	prevent institutional care.
5.	Establish, maintain, and ensure the enforcement of standards for congregate
	housing as may be appropriate to the needs of the residents of congregate
	housing who are receiving services under this chapter. The standards must
	govern matters such as admission policy, safety, sanitation, and protection of civil
	rights.
6.	Establish an individualized care rate for each eligible beneficiary receiving adult
	family foster care services or assisted living services.
7.	Issue payment to basic facilities and adult family foster care facilities for services
	provided to an eligible beneficiary.
8.	Take action and give directions necessary to implement this chapter.
9.	Establish a method to receive complaints related to assisted living facilities and to
	forward the complaints to the appropriate agency for investigation.
