- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 15-20.4 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to the issuance, manufacture, and use of false academic credentials;
- 3 and to provide a penalty.

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4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. A new section to chapter 15-20.4 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:

Unlawful to issue, manufacture, or use false academic credentials - Penalty.

- 1. It is unlawful for a person or entity to knowingly issue or manufacture a false academic credential.
- It is unlawful for a person to knowingly use or claim to have a false academic credential:
 - a. To obtain employment;
 - b. To obtain a promotion or higher compensation in employment;
 - c. To obtain admission to an institution of higher learning; or
- d. In connection with any business, trade, profession, or occupation.
- In this section:
 - a. "False academic credential" means:
 - (1) A degree, certificate, diploma, transcript, or other document purporting to be issued by an institution of higher learning or purporting to indicate that a person has completed an organized academic program of study or completed courses at an institution of higher learning when the person has not completed the organized academic program of study or the courses as indicated on the degree, certificate, diploma, transcript, or document; or
