- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 12.1-32-02.1 of the North Dakota Century
- 2 Code, relating to mandatory prison terms for armed offenders; to provide a penalty; and to
- 3 declare an emergency.

## 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 5 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 12.1-32-02.1 of the North Dakota Century Code 6 is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 7 **12.1-32-02.1. Mandatory prison terms for armed offenders.** Notwithstanding any
- 8 other provision of this title, a term of imprisonment must be imposed upon an offender and
- 9 served without benefit of parole when, in the course of committing an offense, the offender
- 10 inflicts or attempts to inflict bodily injury upon another, threatens or menaces another with
- 11 imminent bodily injury with a dangerous weapon, explosive, destructive device, or firearm, or
- 12 possesses or has within immediate reach and control a dangerous weapon, explosive,
- 13 destructive device, or firearm while in the course of committing an offense under subsection 1
- 14 or, 2, or, except for the simple possession of marijuana, 6 of section 19-03.1-23. This
- 15 requirement applies only when possession of a dangerous weapon, explosive, destructive
- 16 device, or firearm has been charged and admitted or found to be true in the manner provided
- 17 by law, and must be imposed as follows:

- 1. If the offense for which the offender is convicted is a class A or class B felony, the court shall impose a minimum sentence of four years' imprisonment.
- 20 2. If the offense for which the offender is convicted is a class C felony, the court shall impose a minimum sentence of two years' imprisonment.
- This section applies even when being armed is an element of the offense for which the offender is convicted.
- 24 **SECTION 2. EMERGENCY.** This Act is declared to be an emergency measure.
