SENATE BILL NO. 2312 (Senators Kringstad, Dever, Lyson) (Representatives Dosch, Sitte)

AN ACT to provide for a manufactured home installation program.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. Adoption of an installation program. The department of commerce shall adopt rules establishing a manufactured home installation program for all manufactured homes built in accordance with the manufactured homes construction and safety standards under 24 CFR 3280 adopted pursuant to the Manufactured Housing Construction and Safety Standards Act [42 U.S.C. 5401 et. seq.]. The rules must establish minimum installation standards. If required by federal law, the rules may include standards and requirements for licensing and training of installers, inspections of installations, dispute resolution, and penalties for noncompliance. The standards do not apply to manufactured homes installed before the original effective date of the rules. Unless otherwise required by federal law, the standards regarding foundations do not apply to a manufactured home to be installed in a mobile home park if the mobile home park was in existence before the original effective date of the rules and if the manufactured home is installed pursuant to the manufacturer's instructions. The rules must include provisions for the enforcement of these standards.
