BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

| SECTION 1. City or county fingerprinting - Criminal history record. The governing |

| body of a city by ordinance or a county by resolution may require each applicant for a specified |
| occupation with the city or county to provide two sets of fingerprints. The city or county may |
| submit these fingerprints to the bureau of criminal investigation for nationwide criminal history |
| record information that includes resubmission of the fingerprints by the bureau of criminal |
| investigation to the federal bureau of investigation. Federal bureau of investigation criminal |
| history record information obtained by a city or county is confidential. For a request for |
| nationwide criminal history record information made by the city or county under this section, the |
| bureau of criminal investigation is the sole source to receive the fingerprint submissions and |
| responses from the federal bureau of investigation. A person who takes fingerprints under this |
| section may charge a reasonable fee to offset the cost of fingerprinting. The bureau of criminal |
| investigation may charge appropriate fees for criminal history information. |
