1 A BILL for an Act to limit the disclosure of information by consumer reporting agencies.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

3 SECTION 1. Limitation on information disclosed by consumer reporting 4 agencies. A consumer reporting agency may not disclose a person's nonpublic personal 5 information to a third party, regardless of whether that third party is affiliated with the consumer 6 reporting agency, unless the consumer reporting agency has first received the consent of the 7 person to which the information pertains. A valid consent under this section must meet the 8 requirements of section 6-08.1-04. A consumer reporting agency is exempt from the authorization requirements of this section if the disclosure is required to be permitted under the 9 federal Fair Credit Reporting Act [Pub. L. 90-321; 15 U.S.C. 1681 et seq.] or if the disclosure is 10 11 requested by a state or local child support agency. The provisions of the federal Financial 12 Services Modernization Act of 1999 [Pub. L. 106-102; 113 Stat. 1437; 15 U.S.C. 6801 et seq.] 13 do not exempt a consumer reporting agency from the authorization requirements of this 14 section. This section does not restrict the disclosure of information for the purpose of law 15 enforcement.
