- 1 A concurrent resolution urging the boards of county commissioners of counties in the Devils
- 2 Lake Basin to provide property tax fairness and property tax relief to landowners whose
- 3 property has been inundated by rising waters of Devils Lake.
- 4 **WHEREAS**, in recent years rising waters of Devils Lake have inundated over
- 5 80 thousand acres of land in Benson, Towner, Ramsey, and Nelson Counties; and
- 6 WHEREAS, inundation of property has had a disastrous economic impact on affected
- 7 property owners; and
- 8 WHEREAS, the Legislative Assembly has authorized county assessment officials and
- 9 county boards of equalization to provide for fair assessment treatment of owners of inundated
- 10 property and it appears fair assessment treatment is not being provided uniformly for owners of
- 11 inundated property; and
- 12 WHEREAS, appropriate decisions of local government officials provide the best
- 13 opportunity for fair treatment of property owners and the best alternative to mandated property
- 14 tax relief under state law;

- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES
- 16 **OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:**
- 17 That the Legislative Assembly urges the boards of county commissioners of counties in
- 18 the Devils Lake Basin to provide property tax fairness and property tax relief to landowners
- 19 whose property has been inundated by the rising waters of Devils Lake;
- 20 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Secretary of State send copies of this resolution
- 21 to each member of the board of county commissioners in Benson, Towner, Ramsey, and
- 22 Nelson Counties and to each member of the State Board of Equalization.
