

SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 4040

1 A concurrent resolution supporting and honoring the personnel of the Armed Forces of the
2 United States as they enter harm's way around the world and the families of these men and
3 women for their support and sacrifice.

4 **WHEREAS**, the personnel of the Armed Forces of the United States are engaged in
5 deadly combat with the forces of the Iraqi regime of President Saddam Hussein and in a greater
6 war on terrorism around the world; and

7 **WHEREAS**, the sacrifice and honor of the personnel called to active military duty and
8 the support and sacrifices of their families is deserving of the full measure of respect and
9 appreciation of all North Dakotans, which should be conveyed so that the personnel called to
10 active duty and their families have no doubt of the esteem for them in the hearts and minds of
11 North Dakotans; and

12 **WHEREAS**, as in previous conflicts, a large number of North Dakotans are participating
13 in war as members of the regular Armed Forces and as members of the North Dakota National
14 Guard, so much so that North Dakota has a greater share of its population called from the
15 reserves to active duty than any other state;

16 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE**
17 **HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN:**

18 That the Fifty-eighth Legislative Assembly supports and honors the personnel of the
19 Armed Forces of the United States as they enter harm's way around the world and the families
20 of these men and women for their support and sacrifice; and

21 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that copies of this resolution be forwarded by the
22 Secretary of State to the President of the United States, the presiding officers of the United
23 States House of Representatives and the United States Senate, the Secretary of Defense, the
24 Secretary of State, to each member of the North Dakota Congressional Delegation, and to the
25 Adjutant General of North Dakota.
