- 1 A concurrent resolution for the amendment of section 16 of article XI of the Constitution of
- 2 North Dakota, relating to the qualifications for membership in the state's militia; and to provide
- 3 an effective date.

4 STATEMENT OF INTENT

- 5 This measure provides an exception to the age, gender, and residency requirements for the
- 6 militia by allowing volunteers.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE

- 8 SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:
- 9 That the following proposed amendment to section 16 of article XI of the Constitution of
- 10 North Dakota is agreed to and must be submitted to the qualified electors of North Dakota at
- 11 the primary election to be held in 2004, in accordance with section 16 of article IV of the
- 12 Constitution of North Dakota.
- 13 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 16 of article XI of the Constitution of North
- Dakota is amended and reenacted as follows: 14
- 15 Section 16. The militia of this state shall consist of all able-bodied male persons
- 16 individuals residing in the state, between the ages of eighteen and forty-five years, except such
- 17 as may be individuals exempted by the laws of the United States or of this state, and consists
- 18 of individuals who volunteer and are accepted for service in the militia of this state. Persons
- 19 Individuals whose religious tenets or conscientious scruples forbid them to bear arms shall may
- 20 not be compelled to do so in times of peace, but shall pay an equivalent for a personal service.
- 21 **SECTION 2. EFFECTIVE DATE.** If approved by the voters, this measure becomes
- 22 effective on August 1, 2004.
